

A View From the Hill

Seven days ago (as I write), Lucia and I were present to witness and celebrate as one of her sisters was adopted. Tomorrow we'll join the growing band of her birth family and our adoptive families, as we celebrate the adoptions of her two younger brothers.

Later tomorrow I'll officiate at a wedding. The couple isn't part of Nora Church but the groom has done some plumbing at both the church and the parsonage.

Sunday I'll preach for our nearest Unitarian Universalist neighbors in Mankato.

For most of the past two weeks Lucia and I stayed with my mom, hanging out with her and my siblings and their off-spring. I visited college friends and ministerial colleagues, while Lucia made new UU friends at day-camp at my childhood, family church.

In the first two weeks of August alone, here at Nora Church we'll welcome our partner church minister, Ildiko and her husband Csaba for a whirlwind week-long visit, and then travel to Worthington for worship and food and companionship with Unitarian Universalists from Iowa, South Dakota and southwestern Minnesota.

All these connections of family, kin, friends, colleagues, kindred religionists awe and overwhelm me, fill me with gratitude, and call me to mindful attention of our 7th principle in a new light: *Respect for the interdependent web of all existence of which we are a part.*

This principle usually comes to mind when I worry about the plight of the honey bees, the competing interests of wilderness preservation and economic stability, farmers and water-buffer strips. This summer's connections remind me that people comprise the web, too, and the qualities of our relationships—brokenness, reconciliation, forgiveness, hate, playfulness, neighborliness, greed, generosity, vulnerability, trust, betrayal, guardedness, joy, kindness, love—ripple unendingly across the web.

Lucia learned a song at Chalice Camp helps me remember the connections and ripples across the interdependent web of all humanity of which we are a part (a fraction of the interdependent web of all existence). Three verse identical except for the pronouns, “I”, then “You,” and finally, “We”:

It's a blessing we were born
And it matters what we do.
What we know about God
Is a piece of the truth.
Let the beauty we love
Be what we do.
And we don't have to do it alone.

Notes from the Board

The Nora Church board met on July 18. In addition to regular business we heard a report from the Visioning Committee and received a report from Christopher Olson regarding inquiries pertaining to the sound system. At our annual meeting in June it was decided to gather estimates for upgrading our sound system. A congregational meeting will be held on September 10 to consider the needed improvements and costs.

Coffee Hour/ Church Start Time

At our June annual meeting the congregation voted to change the start time for service back to 10:30 with coffee hour scheduled after the service. Several members have rethought this later coffee hour and question the suitability of this schedule. The board discussed this issue at length and decided to abide by the vote of the congregational meeting. Please let board members know if you want to revisit this decision and have a redo of our vote at the congregational meeting already scheduled for Sept. 10. Anyone wishing to start the coffee before church is free to do so.


