VIEW FROM THE HILL



My heart breaks these late days of July for the citizens and residents of Norway.

I feel a special connection to Norway, since I have come to Nora Church and the Hanska community. But even without that tie my heart would be breaking. Like my Facebook friends who announced "today we are all

Norwegians" and the other ones who changed their profile pictures to a flag of Norway, I am caught in the undeniable reality that terror can be unleashed in the world in any place at any moment.

Funeral processions, churches, school yards, college campuses, government buildings, summer camps, centers of business and industry and finance, on nearly every continent.

There will be/are already calls for immediate, swift and decisive action. Gun control, greater freedom to arm and protect ourselves, tighter borders, job creation, more liberal governments and policy, more conservative governments and policies. And none of the immediate simple answers will be **the** answer, because society isn't simple and the issues that drive individuals and groups into acts of terror aren't simple.

The religious response in the face of such acts is straightforward:

Hate cannot drive out hate; only love can do that. (Martin Luther King, Jr.)

Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you. (Matt. 5:44)

Do not do to others what you would not like yourself. Then there will be no resentment against you, either in the family or in the state. (Analects 12:2)

No one of you is a believer until he desires for his brother that which he desires for himself. (Sunnah) What is hateful to you, do not do to your fellowman. This is the entire Law; all the rest is commentary. (Talmud, Shabbat 3id)

Love. Compassion. Straightforward but far from simple. They ask us to slow down. To listen. Pray. Weep. Question and listen more. To change our hearts and change our minds. To expand our definitions of "us" and "we" and "our world". To love and love again and yet again love.

Dog Days of Summer The origins of the name for the most sultry days of the season Source: Columbia Encyclopedia Dog Days is the name for the most sultry period of summer, from about July 3 to Aug. 11. Named in early times by observers in countries bordering the Mediterranean, the period was reckoned as extending from 20 days before to 20 days after the conjunction of Sirius (the dog star) and the sun. In the latitude of the Mediterranean region this period coincided with hot days that were plagued with disease and discomfort. 
